

Undergraduate training programs

All with accreditation



In 2022, 10 undergraduate training programs with 10,079 students:

1. Full-time Medical Doctor (MD, 6 years) : 5,713 students

2. Dental and Maxillofacial Doctor (6 years) : 670 students

3. Preventive Medicine Doctor (PMD, 6 years) : 473 students

4. Traditional Medicine Doctor (6 years) : 638 students

5. Medical image (4 years) : 58 students

6. Pharmacist (5 years) : 726 students

7. Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN, 4 years): 273 students

8. Bachelor in Public Health (BPH, 4 years) : 104 students

9. Bachelor in Laboratory Technique (4 years) : 343 students

10. Bachelor of Science in Midwifery (4 years): 120 students



Postgraduate training programs


In 2022, 91 postgraduate training programs including

- Totally, >13,000 undergraduate + postgraduate students














Healthcare workers in MKD in 2008 vs 2019
