



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
CAN THO UNIVERSITY OF MEDICINE AND PHARMACY
AND
UNIVERSITY "FEDERICO II" OF NAPLES

The Can Tho University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Vietnam, and the University Federico II of Naples, Italy, hereby agree to establish a Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as the "MOU"), in order to promote mutual understanding between the two institutions and to contribute to the advancement and progress through educational and academic collaboration and exchange.

1. Contents of the Programs

Both institutions agree to promote the following exchange programs:

- (1) Exchange of faculty members (and research scholars).
- (2) Exchange of students (including graduate students).
- (3) Exchange of theses, teaching materials, scientific literature, and publications.
- (4) Exchange of information and materials in those fields that are of interest to both parties.
- (5) Promotion of joint research and conduct of collaborative workshops on topics of mutual interests.

2. Term and termination of the MOU

- (1) This MOU shall become effective when the representatives of both institutions put their signatures below and shall remain effective for five years.
- (2) The MOU will be effective for five years and can be renewed upon request of both institutions.

3. Liability and Confidentiality

- (1) It is understood that the details of activities under this program will be negotiated for each specific case, and this Memorandum is entered into solely for the purpose of providing a framework for the negotiations.
- (2) It is also understood that any financial arrangements will be negotiated in each specific case and made depending upon the availability of funds. Each party agrees to seek financial resources to support such exchanges and collaboration.
- (3) Both institutions agree that they shall at all times hereafter use their best endeavors to keep confidential (and to procure that their respective representatives shall keep confidential) the provisions of this MOU and all other information exchanged between the Parties pursuant to

this MOU and/or in the course of their discussions and negotiations.

(4) If any question on any part of the MOU arises, both institutions must consult each other to find a solution.

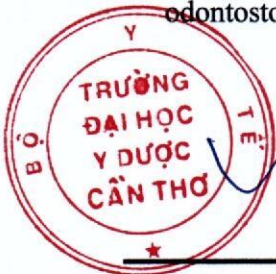

APPENDIX

The bilateral agreement is produced to achieve shared scientific objectives, among which theoretical and practical learning activities for undergraduate and postgraduate university students and periods of mobility towards the involved universities.

APPENDIX 1: Research collaboration

The research collaboration will focus on the areas of Prosthodontics, from the socially oriented removable prostheses to the esthetic-functional rehabilitations performed with the most advanced technologies (digital dentistry, use of intraoral and face scanners, 3D printing, etc.).

APPENDIX 2: Student and Faculty mobility

Unless agreed otherwise agreed, the Institutions, at their own cost, will carry out the mobility or exchange of personnel under the form of:

- Conferences, seminars, workshops, external examinations
- Mobility visits of 1 week to 4 months focusing on specific projects
- Students study abroad (1 semester or summer term)
- Student internships (6-10 weeks, generally in the summer term)

Details of mobility/exchange related to fees, confidentiality, publications, and intellectual property will be governed by separate definitive agreements.

The proposed initial program could be articulated in the following steps:

1. travel of inspection to the Republic of Vietnam in order to give a “one morning” course on the current developments in Dentistry and plan a series of lectures about esthetic and digital technologies;
2. identification of possible locations to perform theoretical and practical “hands-on” courses;
3. discussion on the development of shared laboratory and clinical research projects regarding topics about esthetic and digital Dentistry;
4. discussion about learning exchange programs between the involved parties.
